Part of my visit to Singapore was to allow me to take care of some paperwork in preparation to our final move in November. At the moment, we are faced with a small hurdle concerning our visa. Visa issuance has been tightened, thereby making the process a little more complicated. The government requires that our family be sponsored into the country by an existing Singaporean organization. A few men in Singapore are prayerfully considering how best to help us obtain our visa. Our trust and faith is in the Lord. *Faithful is he that calleth you, who also will do it. Brethren, pray for us. I Thessalonians 5:24-25.* God called us and we know and trust that the details will be fulfilled accordingly and in His time.
